A Message from Nurse Leach

Massachusetts General Law 105CMR200.200 requires that all students entering grade 4 provide the School Nurse with a current physical examination. If your child has not had a physical examination since September 1, 2019, please schedule an appointment and send in a copy of the report upon completion. If your child has had a recent physical examination, please send in a copy if you have not done so already.



Should your child be out of school (virtual or in-person) please call our absent line 339-244-5038 and leave a detailed message including students name, grade, and reason/symptoms. Nurse Leach will contact you with any questions.

Have your student **STAY HOME** if they have any of the following symptoms:

- Temperature of 100.0 F or higher, chills
- Cough (not due to other known cause)
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Headache when in combination with other symptoms
- Muscle/body aches
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Fatigue when in combination with other symptoms
- Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other causes, such as allergies) when in combination with other symptoms
