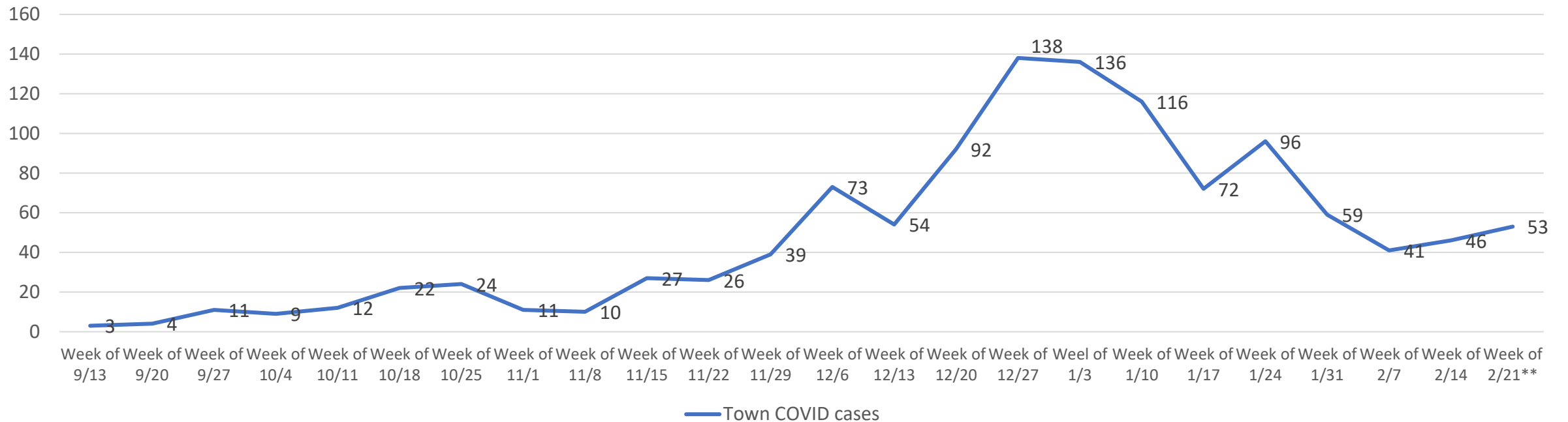

# Updated DESE Guidance: Singing

- 3/1 – DESE Released new guidance for singing indoors:
  - Students must remain masked
  - Students must be at least 10 feet apart
  - When singing indoors duration must be less than 30 minutes
  - Prioritize the use of large well-ventilated spaces
  - Students must all be facing the same direction
  - When indoors students should sing at a lower volume. The lower the volume, the less projection required, therefore minimizing the expelling of droplets.
